Generations Park Grand Opening & Ribbon Cutting

Blair, NE — The City of Blair is proud to announce the grand opening and ribbon cutting ceremony for Generations Park, the city's first new park in more than two decades. The event will take place on **Wednesday, May 14, 2025, at 4:00 PM** at 2233 Civic Drive, on the north side of the Blair Library and Technology Center.

Generations Park expands Blair's award-winning system of parks and trails to over 150 acres of recreational space. The park offers amenities for visitors of all ages and interests:

- **Four Pickleball Courts**
 - Two courts open on a first-come, first-serve basis
 - Two courts are available for reservation
- **Amphitheatre** (available for community and private reservations)
- **Bocce Ball Court**
- **Horseshoe Pits**
- **Splash Pad** (please bring swimsuits!)
- **Restrooms** and additional site amenities

At 4:00 PM, City officials will welcome guests with a brief presentation and recognition of the many community partners, donors, and volunteers whose support made Generations Park possible. The Washington County Chamber of Commerce will provide light refreshments. Mayor Mindy Rump will conclude the program by activating the splash pad—so be ready to get wet and celebrate Blair's newest outdoor destination!
